

Types of Instructional Methods

<p>Lecture One way instruction from facilitator to learners. “Download” information relating to knowledge</p>	<p>Didactic Questioning Asking questions to elicit response. Use of 5Ws and 1H</p>
<p>Explicit Teaching Explanation and elaboration of the subject with examples to help learners understand and relate to the topic</p>	<p>Demonstration Facilitator demonstrates a skill to the learners (e.g. how to put on a life vest)</p>
<p>Drill and Practice Learner practices a topic or skill repeatedly, usually on his own</p>	<p>Inquiry Learners are asked to develop questions to explore and apply the subject matter</p>
<p>Problem Solving Specific real-life issues are given for learners to apply problem solving techniques</p>	<p>Case Studies Scenarios of actual real life cases related to the industry are used for discussions and brainstorming of potential solutions for the cases</p>

<p>Concept Formulation Learners connect pieces of what they have learnt into a bigger concept</p>	<p>Simulation Learners learn through interacting with a simulated environment</p>
<p>Focused Imaging Require learners to visualise (e.g. what you want to be in 5 years' time)</p>	<p>Role Play Learners assume different roles in a learning situation through human interaction</p>
<p>Model Learners build a physical model based on the learning acquired</p>	<p>Game Learners play games to pick up concepts or skills</p>
<p>Debate Learners take different sides of a topic to examine different perspectives</p>	<p>Discussion Learners to talk to each other to generate ideas and opinions of the topic</p>

<p>Brainstorming Learners in groups come together to generate ideas</p>	<p>Experiment Learners try out different things to see what the outcomes are</p>
<p>Reflection Learners reflect on a lesson/experience individually or in group</p>	<p>Peer Learning Learners teach each other or help each other to pick up skills through practising together</p>
<p>Research Project Learners research on learning topics to submit a report</p>	<p>Computer-Aided Instruction Learners learn independently through computer assistance (e-Learning)</p>
<p>Work Assignment Learners complete work assigned by trainer away from class in an allocated time</p>	<p>Field Trip A field trip is a journey by a group of learners to a place away from their normal learning environment.</p>
